The Mechanicsville City Council met in special session Thursday, March 26, 2026 at 102 N John Street, Mechanicsville. Mayor Andrew Oberbreckling was absent. Meeting called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mayor Pro-Tem Randy Brown. Council members present for roll call were Dave Furry, Jim Studer, Zac Randolph, and Tracy Miller.
